The Pick a' Partner Tournament is a one day tournament. The format is a scramble. Teams are constructed with an A player, B player, C player and D player, with those players designated based on handicaps. The A player would be the low-handicapper, the D player the high-handicapper. The only difference is instead of being assigned a team you will have the opportunity to pick which team you want to play on. The picking of the teams will be held Friday evening. If you cannot attend Friday evening, you can still play in the tournament but you will be assigned to a team. Teams are picked by first randomly selecting a letter either A B C or D. If let's say C is drawn; all the participants that are C's are put on the board. There will be only one C on each team. Then another letter is drawn (if for example that letter is A). Each 'A' player as their name is drawn out at random can decide which C player they want to play with. There can only be one 'A' player on each team. Both the B and D level players will get to pick their team in the same fashion as the A players. Team prizes will be based on the number of participants. (MGA will take a % of entry fee).
